**Chinatown** Worth-Hester Sts & Allen - Mulberry Sts. Traditional Chinese shops, restaurants & food markets.

**Chrysler Building** . . . 405 Lexington Avenue, New York City's first skyscraper typifies 1930's art deco.

**Empire State Building** . . 350 Fifth Avenue - 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34<sup>th</sup> Sts. Outdoor Promenade and inside viewing from the 86<sup>th</sup> & 102<sup>nd</sup> floor observatories. Open 7 days a week. Admission.

**Greenwich Village** ... Houston - 14<sup>th</sup> Sts, Broadway-Hudson River - Landmark brownstone neighborhood,

**NBC Studio Tour** . . .30 Rockefeller Plaza (49<sup>th</sup> Street) . . .Behind-the-scenes tour .....Fee for tour

**New York Public Library**... 40 Lincoln Center Plaza - (65<sup>th</sup> St & Columbia Avenue , Landmark Beaux Arts Building. Closed Sun, Monday

**Radio City Music Hall**...Behind the-scenes tours - 1260 Sixth Avenue (50<sup>th</sup> St. Rockefeller Center)

**Rockefeller Center**... 48<sup>th</sup> & 51<sup>st</sup> Sts - between 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue - Out-door dining or ice skating, underground shopping...Free tour book

**St. Patrick's Cathedral** . . .5<sup>th</sup> Ave at 50<sup>th</sup> St. Built in 1858, one of America's finest Gothic-style structures.

**St. Peter's Church**...619 Lexington Avenue at 54<sup>th</sup> Street. Open to Public daily. Tours

**Time Square** . . . Broadway - 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. . . Hub of Broadway theater district, theater tickets, Visitor Center

**United Nations** . . .1<sup>st</sup> Avenue between 42<sup>nd</sup> & 46<sup>th</sup> Streets. Guided tours daily. . . . Admission

**Wall Street** ..... Lower Manhattan between South Street (East River) and Broadway

**World Financial Center/Winter Garden**... West St. between. Liberty and Vesey Sts. Singular waterfront complex overlooks the Hudson River with shops, restaurants, public gardens and free events.
